Students can select from a variety of activities that constitute their portfolio: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - helping in the (co)organization of a workshop or conference, - internship / guest stay with a research institution, - internship / guest stay with an academic publishing house, - participation in a conference or workshop (if possible with student's own submission, e.g. full paper or poster presentation), - submitting a first small publication (e.g. in a conference / workshop proceedings), - teaching a tutorial within one of the faculty's study programs - submitting a first small publication (e.g. in a conference / workshop proceedings), - teaching a tutorial within one of the faculty's study programs.
