Learning contents Lerninhalte	Students individually organise their active participation in various forms of academic work and practice in co-operation and under the supervision of their mentor. Students can select from a variety of activities that constitute their portfolio: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- helping in the (co)organization of a workshop or conference,</li> <li>- internship / guest stay with a research institution,</li> <li>- internship / guest stay with an academic publishing house,</li> <li>- participation in a conference or workshop (if possible with student's own submission, e.g. full paper or poster presentation),</li> <li>- submitting a first small publication (e.g. in a conference / workshop proceedings),</li> <li>- teaching a tutorial within one of the faculty's study programs.</li> </ul>
