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# Background

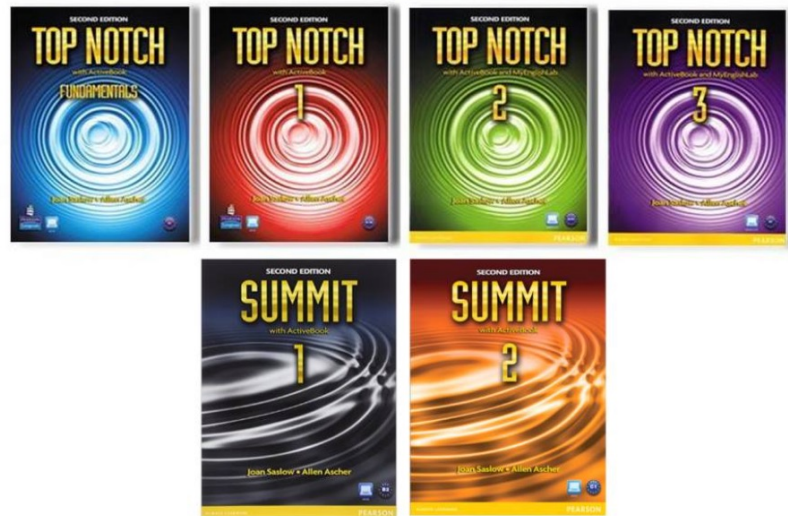


BTEC FPT British College is one of the colleges that focuses a lot on training English as a primary language of communication.

# Reasons and aims of the research

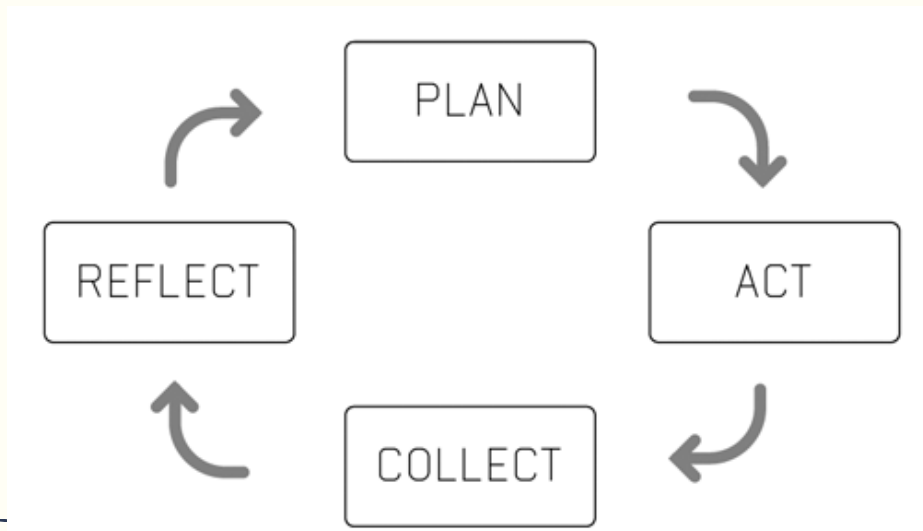

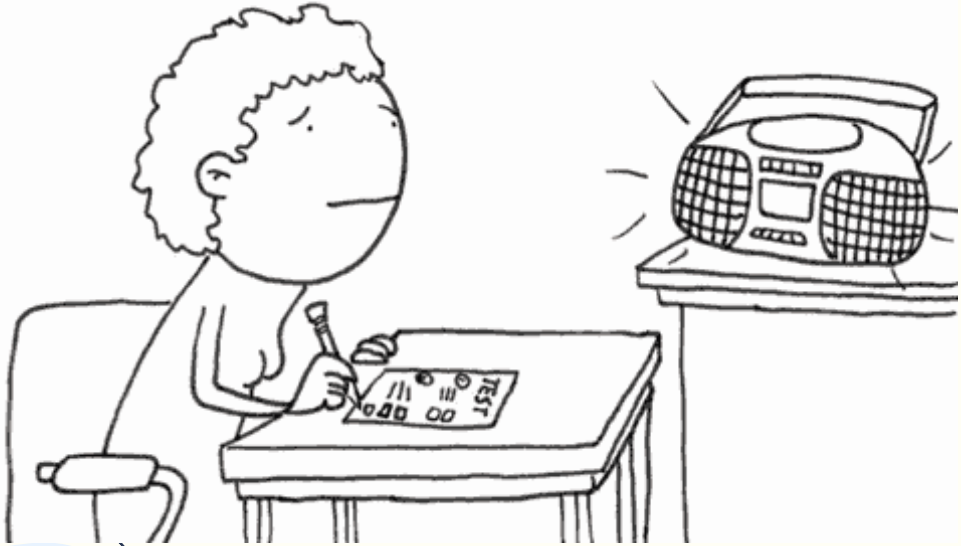

Preference trend of students toward different forms of activities

|            | Most liked | Liked  | Neutral | Unliked | Total |
|------------|------------|--------|---------|---------|-------|
| Pair-work  | 47.83%     | 34.78% | 15.22%  | 2.17%   | 100%  |
| Group-work | 41.30%     | 39.13% | 19.57%  | -       | 100%  |
| Class-work | 54.35%     | 28.24% | 17.39%  | -       | 100%  |

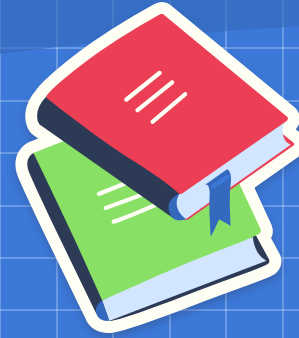
## Statistics on two test results
